St. Pious X Degree & PG College is a Catholic minority institution for women established and managed by the congregation of Catechist Sisters of St. Ann founded in 1993 with 90 students enrolled in three undergraduate programs. It currently caters to 2600 women students pursuing higher education, 96 highly qualified and experienced faculty members, 35 administrative and support staff and offers 16 under graduate and 6 postgraduate programs.

The institution completed 30 successful years and is dedicated to provide students with a high-quality holistic education, offering them the freedom of a more industry-focused curriculum.
