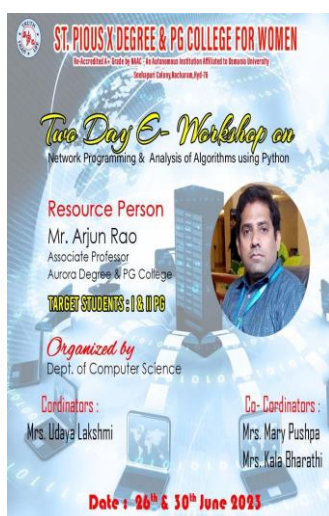
24-06-2023: WORKSHOP ON “MS-OFFICE TOOLS”

26-06-2023: WORKSHOP ON “NETWORK PROGRAMMING AND ANALYSIS OF ALGORITHMS USING PYTHON”

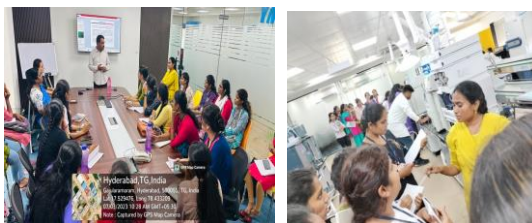

The Department of chemistry had organized a workshop cum On-site Lab training as a part of MoU activity in association with YMC School of Chromatography, Medchal, Hyderabad on 3rd July,2023. Altogether 30 students of M.Sc previous and second year along with Mrs. Archana Juyal and Dr. Snehalatha attended the workshop organized in two sessions at YMC School. During the first session Dr. G.Srinivasa Rao, Director lab Projects, YMC gave a brief introduction of YMC School along with the basics of HPLC . In his interactive session Dr. G. Srinivas explained the principle and techniques to be adopted during analysis

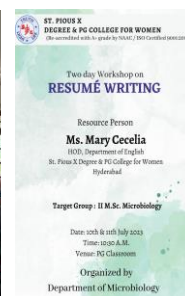

28-08-2023: SESSION ON DISCOVER WHETHER STARTUP IS A GROWING TREND OR A CURRENT FAB

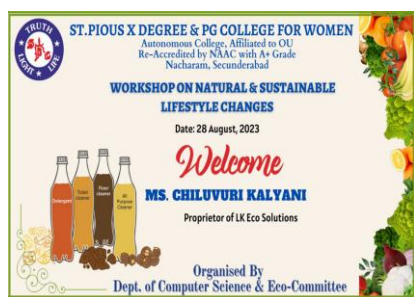

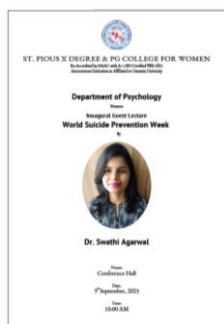


09-09-2023: AWARENESS SESSION ON SUICIDE PREVENTION

The Department of Psychology organized a session on Suicide Prevention Awareness, delivered by Dr. Swathi Agarwal, Co-Founder of Gargi Knowledge Solutions on 9th September 2023 in the Conference Hall. The lecture was targeted to 56 B.A MPML students and focused on

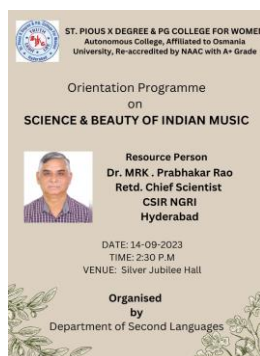

Dr. Swathi Agarwal emphasized the importance of recognizing signs that someone may be at risk of suicide, including changes in behaviour, mood, and communication patterns. The session stressed the need to make a conscious decision to respond when signs of suicidal thoughts are observed, rather than ignoring or dismissing them. Practical steps for taking action were outlined, including approaching the person in a safe and supportive manner. The session highlighted the critical role of active listening, offering empathy, and providing unwavering support to those in distress.

Dr. Swathi recommended acknowledging the person's pain and offering a sincere apology, which can help validate their feelings and open a pathway for further conversation and support. The session ended with a few of the attendees sharing their experience with losing someone to suicide, including Ms. Aarthi Deepak, Head, Department of Social Sciences.



14-09-2023: ORIENTATION SESSION ON “SCIENCE & BEAUTY OF INDIAN MUSIC”

The **coordinators** of the Course were Mrs. Monoshri Mitra, Faculty, Department of English and Mrs. Madhavi, Dept. of Commerce. The **duration** of the course was 30 hours. The **resource person** was Mr. D. N. Srinivas, Asst. Professor (Contract), German Department, Arts College, Osmania University. The classes **commenced** on 19th September, 2023. **63 students** opted for the course and attended the classes regularly in the college. Arrangements were made to conduct the course on campus within the college hours, from 12:30 to 3:30 PM for ten days. **Attendance** was monitored every day and recorded in the class register. The **syllabus** of the course was as follows:

1: Letters, Word pronunciation, Basic sentences, Verb Conjugation, Personal pronouns

- 2: Introduction of Nouns, introduction of Cases, Numbers, Time
- 3: Nominative, Accusative cases, Possessive pronouns, Basic conversation
- 4: Dative case, Modal Verbs, Imperative, Self-introduction
- 5: Conjunctions, Revision, Reflexive pronouns
- 6: Test (oral and written)

A **test** was conducted at the end of the course and the papers were evaluated with constructive feedback by Mr. D.N. Srinivas. **Feedback** on the course was collected from the participants on completion of the course on a prescribed form by the course coordinators. The classes **completed** on 30th September, 2023.

19-09-2023: CERTIFICATE COURSE ON YOGA & MEDITATION

The Yoga & Meditation certificate course was conducted by Certificate course committee of St. Pious X Degree & PG College For women, Nacharam from 19th September 2023 to 30th September 2023, 30 hours (3hours per day/10days) for first year undergraduate students. The students were introduced to the basics of Fashion Designing and the importance of Grooming. Colour theory and Color psychology were taught to the students which helps in learning the use of colors to create different effects and mood in their paintings or designs. Famous Painting styles like Varli and Kantha, Kalamkari and Kasuti were explained and the students took keen interest in them. The students were

fascinated in learning these new techniques and styles. Different techniques of Designing were also taught. Dry strokes with Pearl Metallic Gold outline, wet on Wet, Accident stroking or texture effect are some notable mentions. 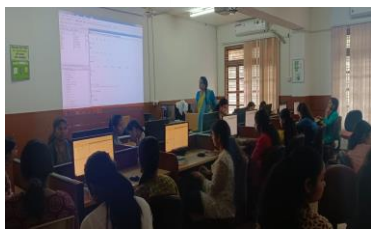
The workshop was held in MBA Department computer lab on 9th and 10th November 2023. The students were given participation certificates.

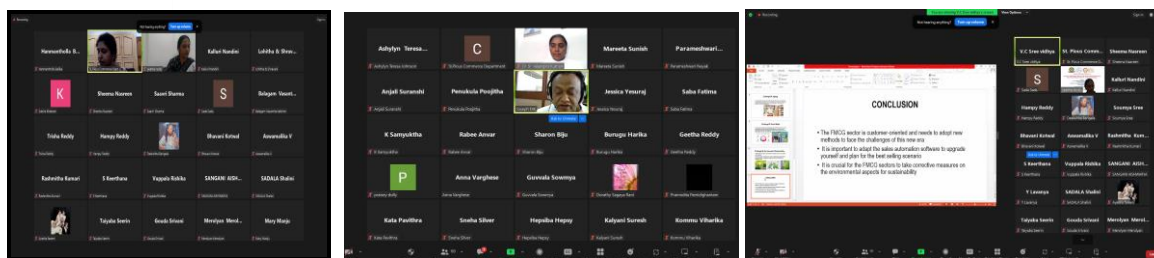

The session underscored the necessity for collaborative efforts among stakeholders to ensure the efficacy and relevance of consumer protection legislation in an evolving marketplace landscape.

With a robust line-up of four technical sessions and 27 paper presentations including 24 Students 11 Faculty and the webinar attracted an enthusiastic participation of approximately 300 attendees. The Department of Botany and Biotechnology organized “Capacity Building program – YOGA” for all the I & III years of BtBC and BtMC students on 1 April 2024.

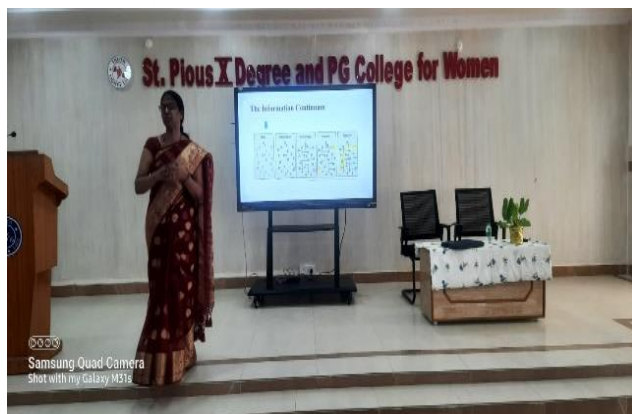
