WORKSHOPS:

A THREE-DAY WORKSHOP ON BIO -INFORMATICS

A three-day workshop on Bio - informatics was organized by the Department of Biochemistry from 16 to 18 November 2021. The workshop was designed to familiarize the Undergraduate final year Life Sciences (III BCMC) students with the basics in Bioinformatics and provide hands-on-training to the students through a pragmatic approach.

The Principal, Sr. B. Velangini Kumari motivated the students and appreciated Dr. Arvind Setty for the consistent support through Ruha Life sciences. Ms. C. Vanisree, Head, Department of Biochemistry, described how Bioinformatics helps in solving biological problems. Dr. Arvind Setty, Director, Ruha Life Sciences, explained the significance of Bioinformatics in various fields of Biology followed by a practical session -I on sequence retrieval and databases, alignment tools. The next lecture was on Structural databases, replication, transcription and translation and tools to study protein structure which was followed by practical session-2 on study of 3D structure of Proteins. The subsequent practical session on functional analysis of Biomolecules was followed by an assessment test. On completion of assessment test participation certificates were awarded to students.

WORKSHOP ON MASS PRODUCTION OF ORGANIC LIQUID BIO FERTILIZER

On 18 November 2021, the Departments of Botany & Biotechnology in collaboration with ED Cell of the College organized a workshop for Life Sciences students on “Mass Production of Organic Liquid Bio Fertilizer”. This can be used as foliar spray; it decomposes on vegetable waste and is useful for soil application. Students learnt the need to use organic bio- fertilizers to protect soil health and control of pests on crops. They demonstrated the preparation of liquid bio-fertilizer using Jaggery, Microbial culture and water which was subject to fermentation for 7 days. Students were encouraged to do the process at home and spread the awareness about this preparation in their local community. Around 90 students participated in the workshop.

TWO-WEEK WORKSHOP ON TRADITIONAL ECOLOGICAL KNOWLEDGE AND ITS DEVELOPMENT USING SOFTWARE

The Department of Botany & Biotechnology conducted a workshop on “Traditional Ecological Knowledge and its Development using software” from 9 - 22 December 2021. The workshop involved the documentation of trees, shrubs and ornamental plants present in the college campus using QR Code for each plant. 54 II BTBC & BTMC students participated in the workshop.

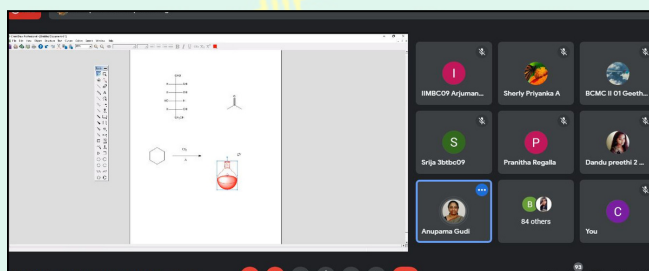

The Departments of Botany & Biotechnology in collaboration with the Research Committee organized a two-day online National seminar on “Intellectual Property Rights and Research Ethics” on 21 & 22 October 2021. It was focused on various aspects of IP and its importance.

- Dr. Balaji Devarajan, Professor and Head of Center for IPR in KPRIET, spoke on the topic ‘IPR as a tool for Innovation’. He presented the basics of IP like Critical thinking & Creative thinking and motivated the participants to go for IPR if they have innovative ideas before sharing them on any forum. He emphasized on the balancing of left brain & right brain for innovative thinking and to keep in mind that whatever product we develop should be used by consumers. He suggested 10 ways to boost our thinking ability which can be adapted in our day-to-day life.
- Dr. C.R. Rene Robin, Professor and Dean (Innovation) at Sairam Group of Institutions, Chennai, drew attention to “Creative and Nurturing Innovation Ecosystem through IP”. He focused on Ideation, Collaboration, Value Creation, importance of IPR, Women Scientists Scheme and Top 10 Indian applications for patents from academic institutions.
- Dr. Rathish, Assistant Professor, IUCIPRS, CUSAT Cochin University, emphasized on “A Panoramic perspective of Patent system in India”. He gave an extensive talk on patent rights, exceptions, reasons for filing patents, patentability exercise, statutory fees in India, patent filing procedure both in India and foreign countries, Do’s and Don’ts and their limitations in filing patents.

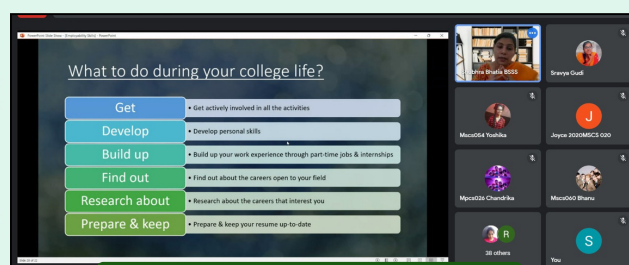

- The Chief guest, Mr. T. Suresh, Professor and Advisor for Government of Telangana and Andhra Pradesh Start-up, stressed on climate change and how these days climate change has become an economic eruption. He also spoke about how one can contribute to removing digital poverty and said that the country should be developed technologically.
- Guest of Honour Prof. S. Pardhasaradhi, Dept. of Business Administration, St. Pious X PG (MBA) College for Women, the Convenor of the Conference, focused on the importance of multidisciplinary research, behavioral economics systems.
- The Keynote address was by Prof. Surein Rheeder, Director of Studies Waltham International College UK, Author and Teacher Educator, University of West Georgia. She dealt with technology innovation and provided its importance towards Social Sciences for economic development. She also said that a country like India should adopt a sociological and historical approach in development.

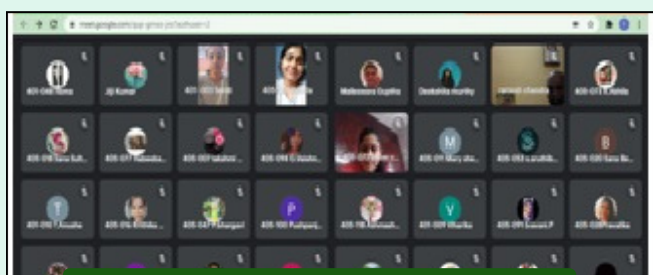

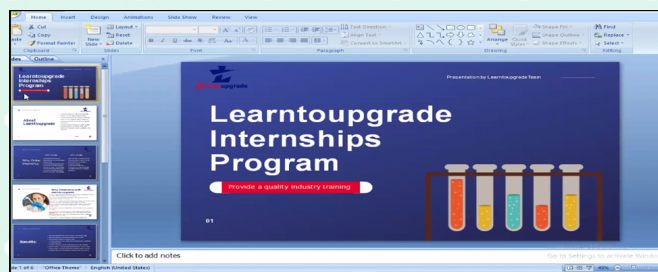


Orientation on Tally Certificate course

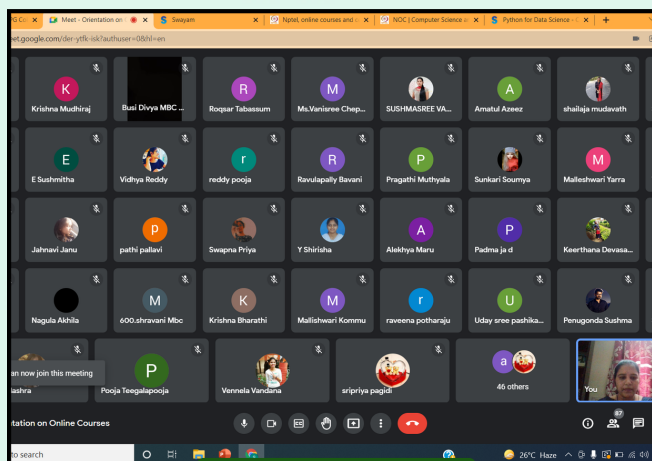

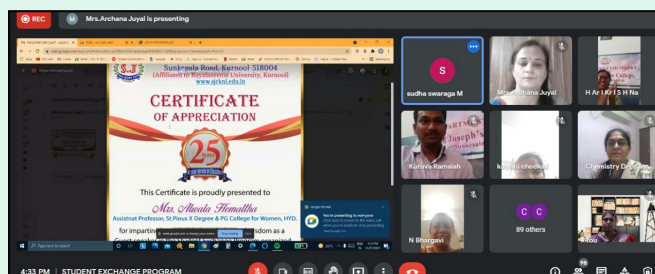

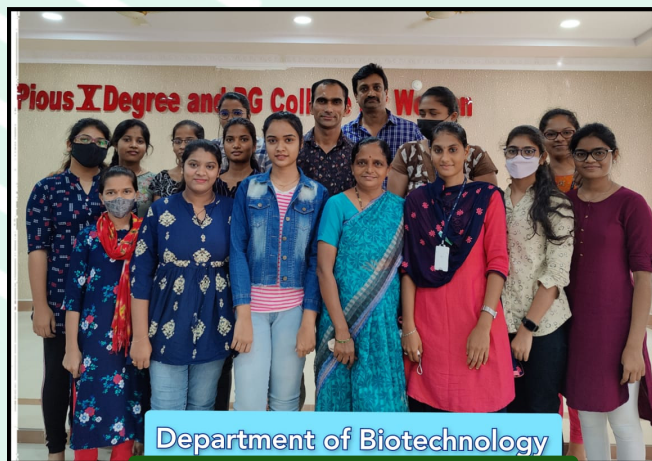
CAREER GUIDANCE

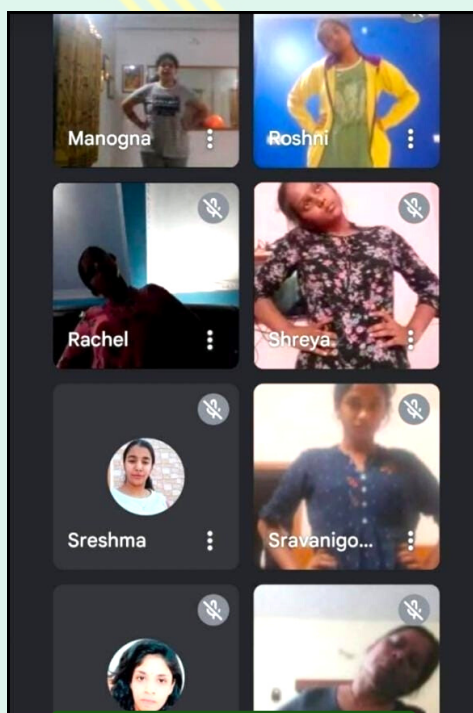

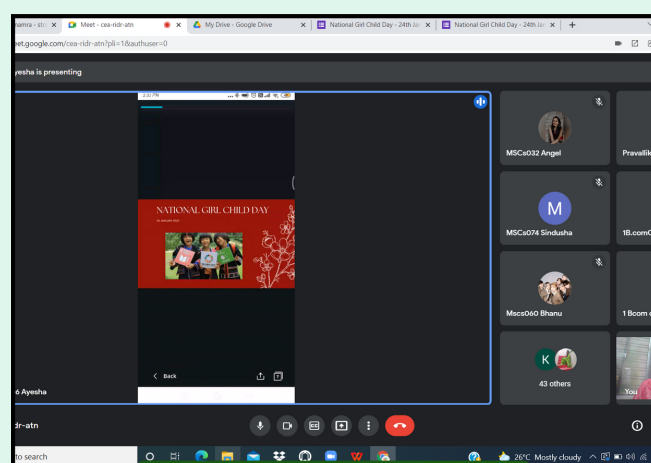
National Girl Child Day – 2022

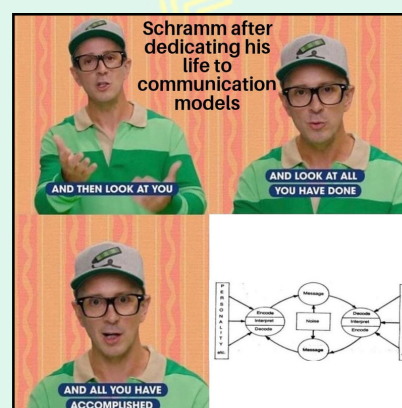
