On the day of finale we got to present our idea before the jury and recieved 3rd place in the competition with a cash prize of 6,000 rupees and recieved the award from food and civil supplies minister of Telangana - Gangula Kamalakar and IAS Jayesh Ranjan.

Two panels of 6 judges each was allotted to us. Inaugural session at our Institute level was conducted at 8.00 am on 22nd June 2021. The chief guest for the Inaugural was Prof. Limbadri, Vice Chairman, Telengana State Council for Higher Education. The guest of honour for this session was Ms. Deepika Joshi, Director ,Founder Ideovate Solutions.

For the power judging round we were allotted a new set of panellists and new teams to be coordinated.
