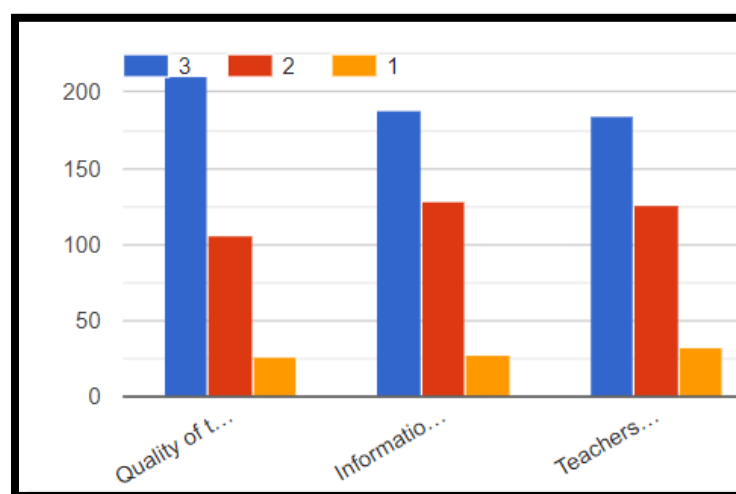

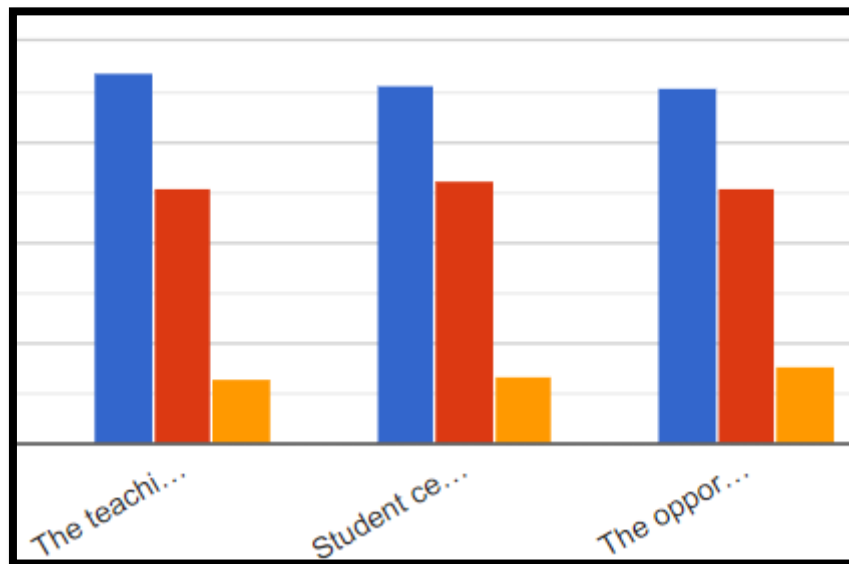
1. Quality of teaching is primary focus of the Institution.

Interpretation (1, 2, 3 Qs.)

- For an Institution, the growth depends primarily on the quality of Teachers and Students. In this regard more than 93 % of the respondents' have expressed high satisfaction on the Quality of teaching being the primary focus of the Institution.
 - Equal percentage of students also agreed that the information about the Course design and outcomes were clearly explained to them.
 - Around 9 % of the students expressed concerns over non completion of syllabus with revisions. This could have been due to the disturbance caused due to Covid pandemic. This need to be monitored in the future.
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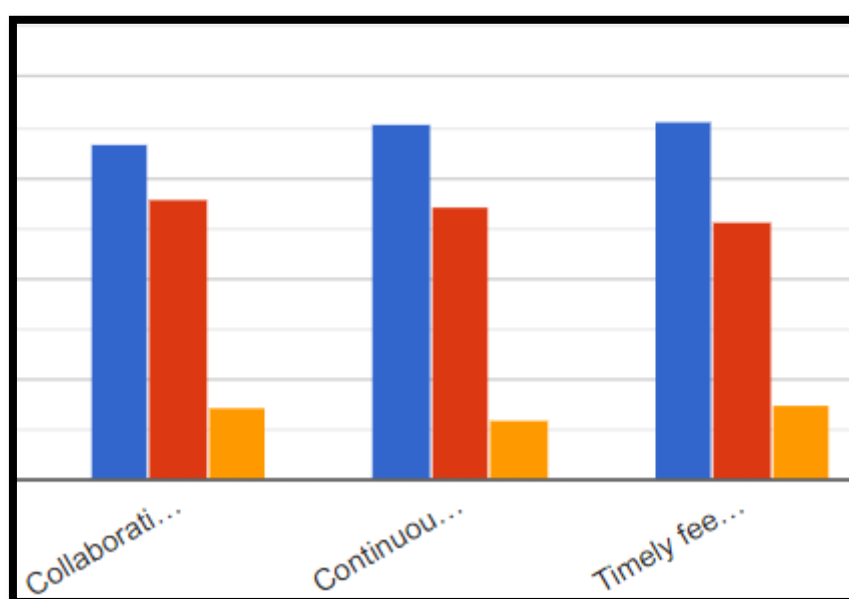
4. The teaching and mentoring process in your institution facilitates your cognitive, social and emotional growth.

Interpretation (4, 5, 6 Qs.)

 - With more than 53 % of students strongly agreeing and 37 % positively agreeing towards various teaching pedagogies is encouraging the teachers to be more creative and innovative in teaching styles.
 - More opportunities need to be provided towards research and critical thinking.
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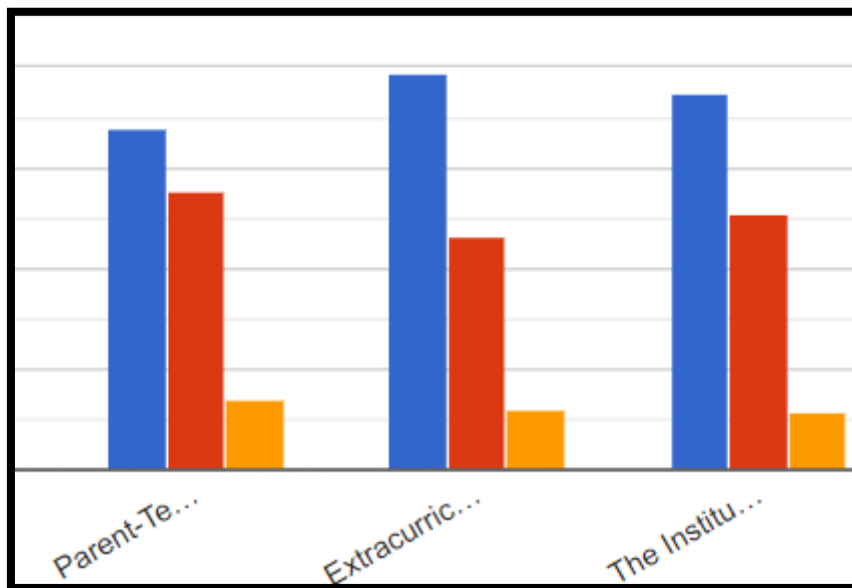
7. Collaborations and Linkages between the Institution and Industry pave way for Academic Excellence

 - 90 % of the students agreed that the Continuous cumulative evaluation resulted in monitoring their academic performance.
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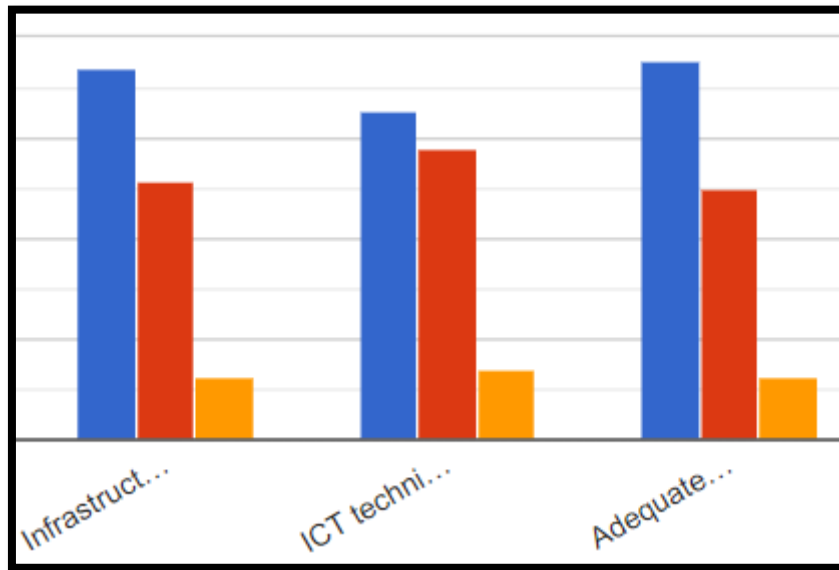
10. Parent-Teachers interactions in the Institution is effective.

 - Students were encouraged to enrol for online courses through Coursera, Spoken Tutorial and many more which resulted in a good feedback in this regard.
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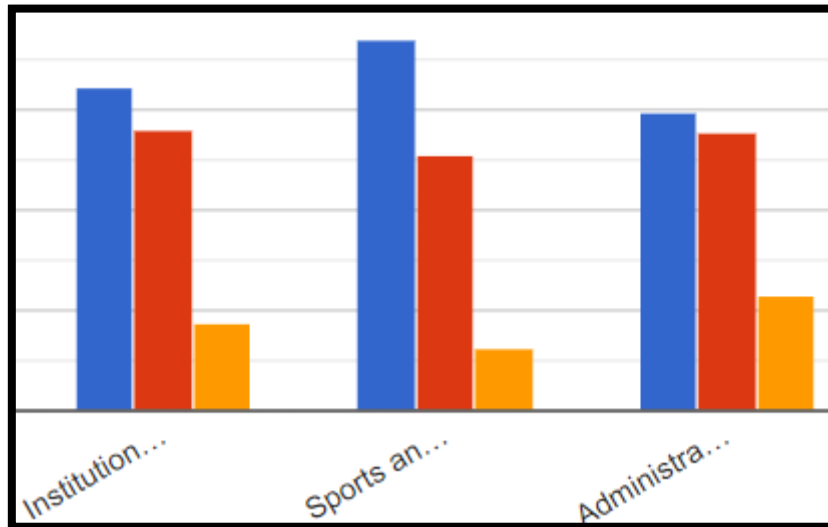
13. Infrastructure facilities in your institution are adequate and enhance the quality of education.

 18. Administrative Office staff extend support when required.

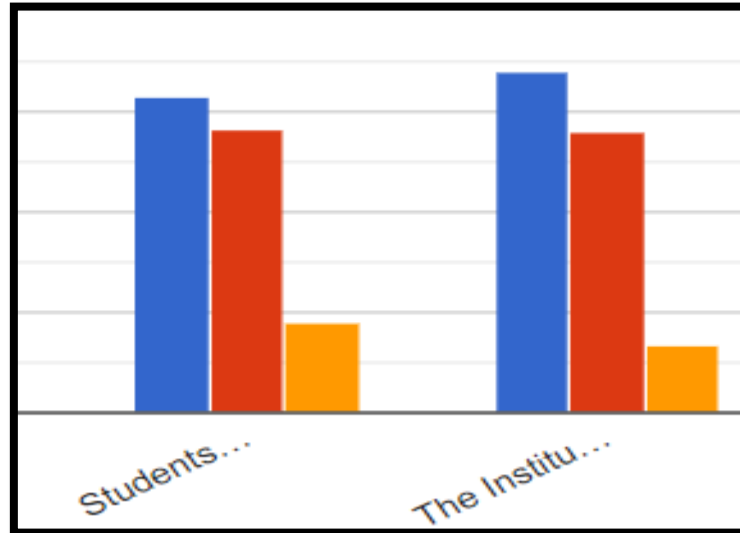


Interpretation (16, 17, 18 Qs.)
