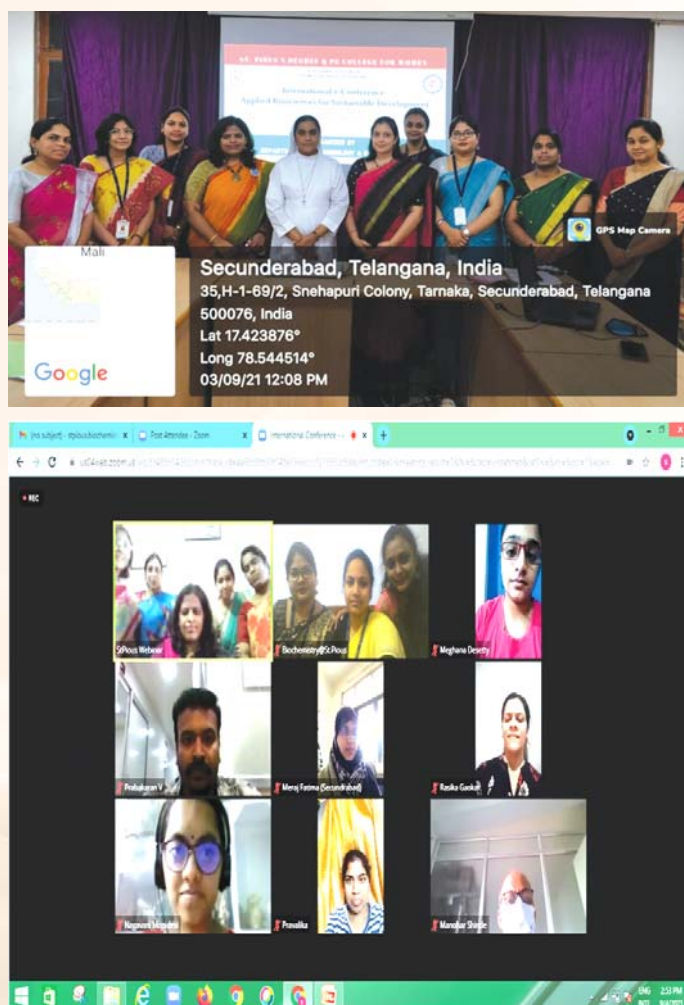
Two-day International E-Conference - Applied Biosciences for Sustainable Development

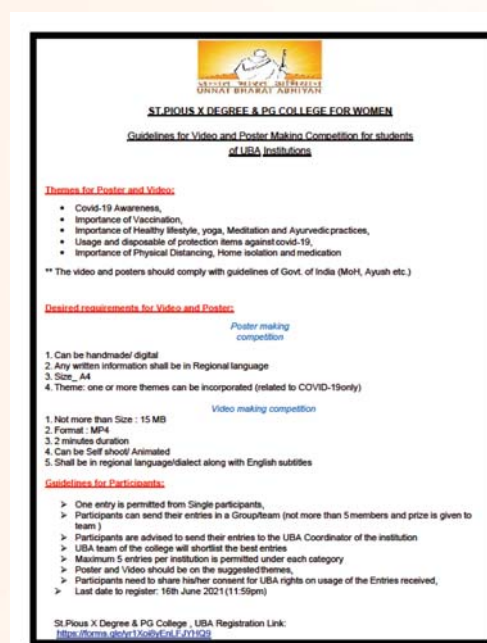
❖ Fit India Freedom Run 2.0

The Department of Physical Education and Dept. of Psychology conducted Ice Breaking session on 21st September 2021 at 11.00 AM.



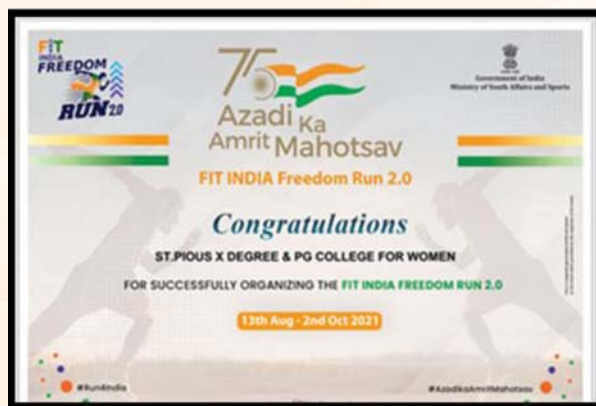
Heart Day:
